Working with the film will help to awaken compassion, empathy, consciousness, respect in students. In difficult times there is a problem of indifference. This film is a great example of how to treat your neighbor regardless of his religious preferences.

What is the mission of the project?

The mission is to inspire children to remember the past in order not to repeat history again.

There are assimilated Jews in our school. They often forget about their roots and history. Inside their families they often do not pay attention to it. There are also ordinary Ukrainians in our school. Due to difficult circumstances, there is anti-Semitic sentiment even in the middle school where I teach: such as comments and humor about it. The purpose of the lesson is to show how a simple Ukrainian family risked its future and succeeded in helping a Jewish family as an example to follow.
