

## CJN video competition Checklist

When creating your video, please make sure to include everything from the following checklist!

<b>Beginning of the film</b>	The film has a title	
	The year is shown	
	Clear beginning with a short introduction	
<b>Ending of the film</b>	Smooth ending without any sudden “cut”	
	Name of student(s) who worked on the film	
	Name of teacher(s)	
	Name of school	
	Credits for sources of information, images, and music used in the film	
<b>Story</b>	Smooth storyflow: the film has an introduction, a middle section, and an ending	
	The video is interesting to watch. It elicits curiosity and a desire to know more	
	The facts and content of the film are historically accurate	
<b>Subtitles</b>	The video has subtitles	
	Readable subtitles (they don’t disappear too fast; their color is different from the background)	
	Correct grammar, spelling and punctuation	
<b>Audio</b>	No loud background noise	
	The music is relevant to the film, it is not too loud or wordy	
	Clear sound and understandable narration	
	Grammatically correct narration, good pronunciation	
<b>Images</b>	If you use your phone: hold it horizontally, never vertically	
	Video footages are good quality, not too dark, not shaky	
	As many original photos and documents were used as possible	
	Images used in the film are relevant and connect to the topic
