Checklist for Video Projects

When creating your video, please make sure to include everything from the following checklist!

Beginning of the Film	The film has a title	
	The year is shown	
	The film begins with a short introduction	
Ending of the Film	The film has a smooth ending (no sudden cuts)	
	Names of student(s) who worked on the film are included	
	Names of teacher(s) are included	
	Name of the school is included	
	Credits are given for all sources of information, images, and music used in the film	
Story	The story flows smoothly — the film has a clear beginning, middle, and end	
	The video is engaging and sparks curiosity or a desire to learn more	
	The facts and content are historically accurate	
Subtitles	The video includes subtitles	
	Subtitles are easy to read (they stay on screen long enough and contrast with the background)	
	Grammar, spelling, and punctuation are correct	
Audio	No loud background noise	
	The music fits the tone of the film and is not too loud or distracting	
	The narration is clear and easy to understand	
	The narration is grammatically correct and well-pronounced	
Images	If using a phone, hold it horizontally (never vertically)	
	Video footage is of good quality — not too dark or shaky	
	Original photos and documents are used whenever possible	
	Images are relevant and support the topic of the film
